

CUT




- 6 squares $3^{1}/_{2}$ " x $3^{1}/_{2}$ " background fabric
- 5 squares $4^{1}/_{2}$ " x $4^{1}/_{2}$ " background fabric
- 2 squares $4^1/2^n \times 4^1/2^n$ blue fabric
- 3 squares $4^{1}/_{2}$ " x $4^{1}/_{2}$ " pink fabric




How to make Half Squre Triangle (HST)


1. Draw a diagonal line corner to corner on the light (background) square as shown on the diagram (1)




2. Put the light (background) $4^{1}/_{2}$ " x $4^{1}/_{2}$ " square on the blue/pink $4^{1}/_{2}$ " x $4^{1}/_{2}$ " square, right side together and sew a $1/_{4}$ " on each side of the drawn line - diagram (2)



3. Cut apart on the drawn line you made two HST units - diagram (3)





4. Press it open and trim to $3^{1}/_{2}$ " x $3^{1}/_{2}$ " square.




