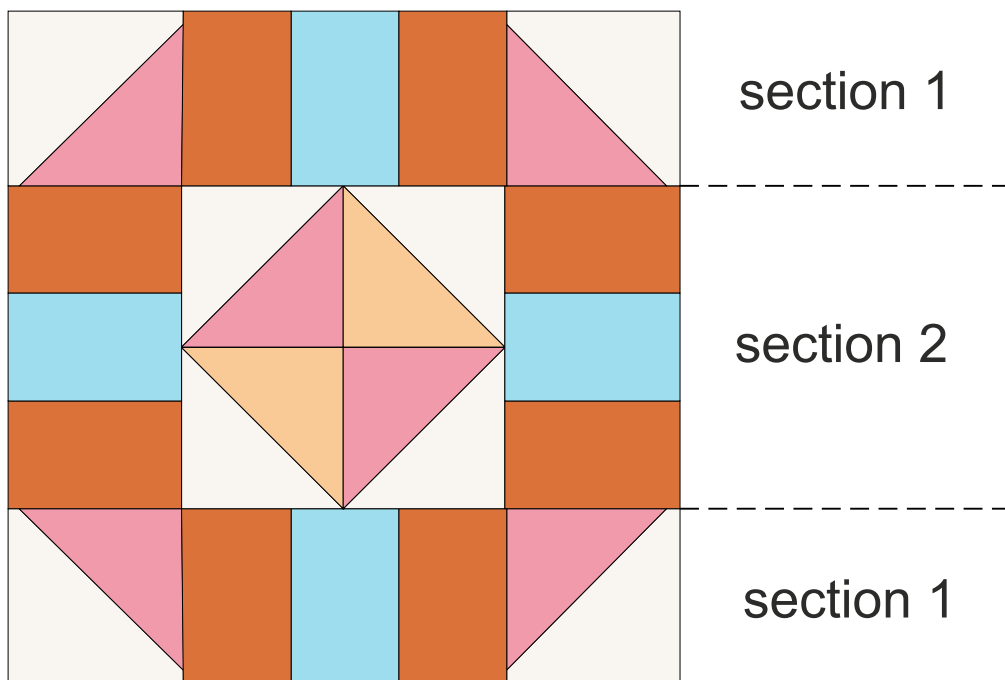

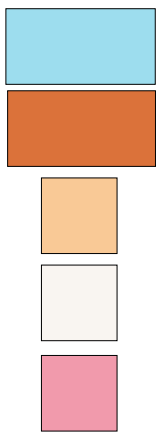
BLOCK N° 7
CROSS ROADS



Unfinished size $12\frac{1}{2}$ " x $12\frac{1}{2}$ "



CUT



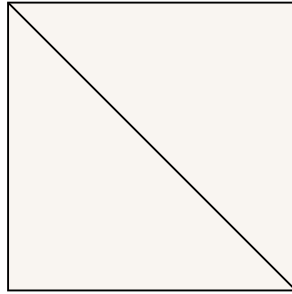
- 4 rectangles $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x $3\frac{1}{2}$ " blue fabric
- 8 rectangles $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x $3\frac{1}{2}$ " dark brown fabric
- 1 square $4\frac{1}{2}$ " x $4\frac{1}{2}$ " light brown fabric
- 4 squares $4\frac{1}{2}$ " x $4\frac{1}{2}$ " background fabric
- 3 squares $4\frac{1}{2}$ " x $4\frac{1}{2}$ " pink fabric



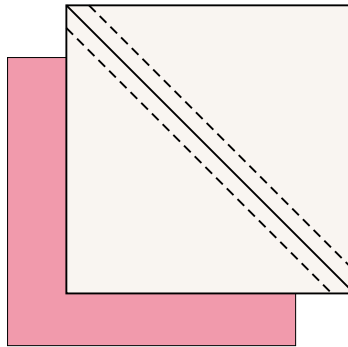
With background fabric squares
and pink and light brown fabrics make HST

How to make Half Square Triangle (HST)

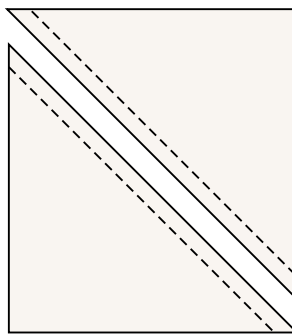
1. Draw a diagonal line corner to corner on the light (background) square as shown on the diagram (1)



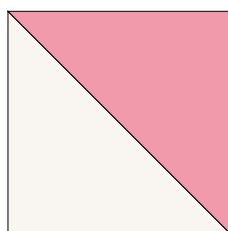
2. Put the light (background) $4\frac{1}{2}$ " x $4\frac{1}{2}$ " square on the light brown/pink $4\frac{1}{2}$ " x $4\frac{1}{2}$ " square, right side together and sew a $\frac{1}{4}$ " on each side of the drawn line - diagram (2)



3. Cut apart on the drawn line you made two HST units - diagram (3)

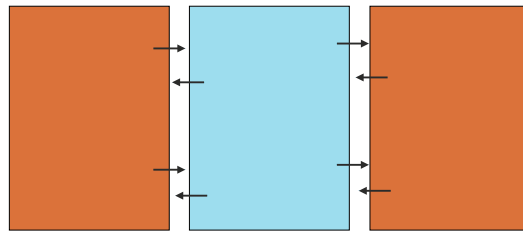


4. Press it open and trim to $3\frac{1}{2}$ " x $3\frac{1}{2}$ " square.

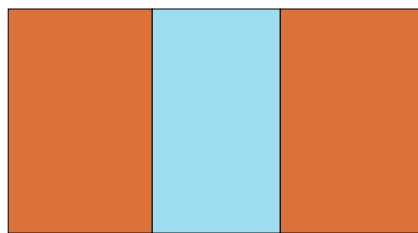

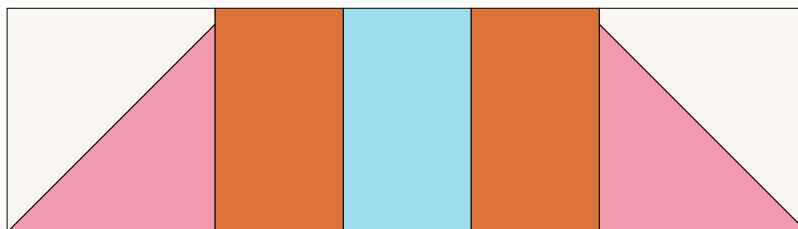
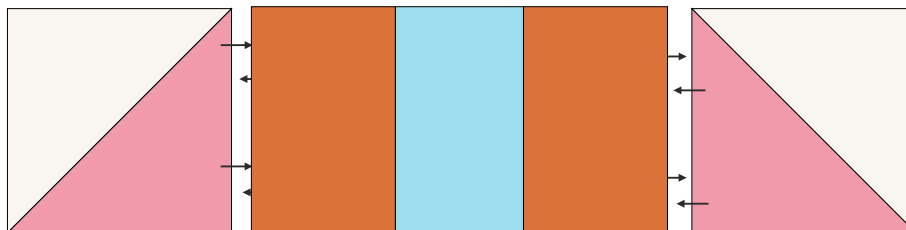
3 strips ($2\frac{1}{2}$ " x $3\frac{1}{2}$ ") sew together and make
